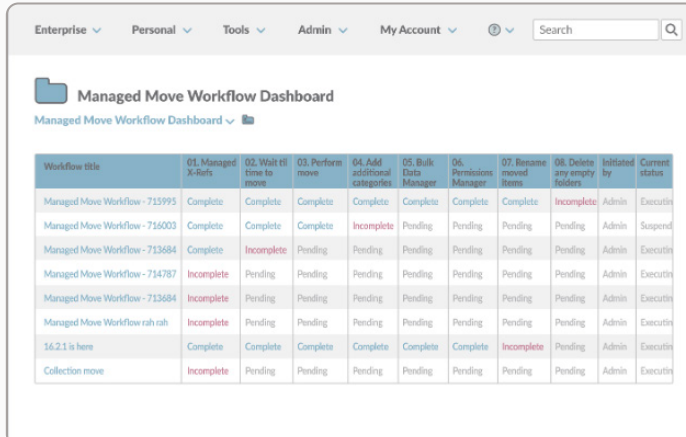

Automated internal migrations
